

## **Spring Hill Farm**

Spring Hill Farm

Preserved by

In Memory of Mary B. Scott

Gift of Joan Mayhew

Spring Hill Farm was originally purchased in 1895 by Adeline Post. In May 2006, 111 years later, Mrs. Post's great-granddaughter, Joan Mayhew, donated it to the Bourne Conservation Trust. This very generous gift was made in memory of Joan's aunt, Mary B. Scott who loved Spring Hill Farm and would be pleased to know that it will be preserved.

At present, Spring Hill Farm is 3.5 income acres of rolling pasture with a barn and "carriage shed." The east end of the property is high ground with a spectacular view over the cranberry bogs and ponds, a perfect spot for viewing sunrises. On some nights, from a low area near the barn one can look up and see the moon over the steeple of the Cataumet Methodist Church. On most nights, the resident owl can be heard. The

can be heard. The west side fronts on County Road in Cataumet, across the street from the cemetery.

The barn that still graces the property was built

around 1910 by Mrs. Post's grandson, Charlie Scott. Charlie used the land for his gardens and to keep cows and chickens.


It was also around that time it was named Spring Hill Farm and that the carriage shed was moved from behind the church to its present location between the house and the barn. (Originally the farm included the old parsonage, just north of the church.) The carriage shed was first used as a chicken hatchery, then it became a bunk house, and in the mid 1970's it was converted to a house and has been Joan Mayhew's home ever since.

Joan has retained lifetime use of the property and continues to live in the converted carriage shed.

The farm is also home to 2 goats, a horse and a pony.

It is the BCT's intention to maintain this property as farmland. To that end, considerable work was done in the fall removing underbrush, dead trees and branches, and planting grass.

Contractors, paid for by the BCT, and volunteers accomplished a dramatic transformation. Although the farm is not currently open to the public, the barn and land can be viewed from the street. It is our hope to have an open house in the

spring or early summer to allow our members and friends to walk the property and to meet and chat with Mrs. Mayhew (watch for notices). Joan has also promised to share her memories of Spring Hill Farm and its history for our next newsletter.



#### 2006 IN REVIEW

## It was a very good year!

Cobb Corner, a gift from the late Mary Susan Cobb in December of 2005, is a half-acre field, maple grove, and stream located at the corner of County and Scraggy Neck roads. In 2006 the deadfall and underbrush was removed, and a fence and bench were installed. The cleanup was a volunteer effort as is the ongoing

maintenance. Cobb Corner does much to maintain the rural character of the entrance to Cataumet Village. In addition to this generous gift, Mrs. Cobb bequeathed \$10,000 to the Bourne Conservation Trust.

In February, the BCT purchased the George S. Read Woodland for \$200,000. At the time of closing on this property, it was necessary to take out a mortgage (see October). This woodland comprises 2.3 acres and is located on Red Brook Harbor Road in Cataumet. This acquisition extends the Cataumet Greenway and is home to many birds and other small animals.

**In June**, the BCT received the Pond Island Cranberry Bog. This 3 acre retired cranberry bog was a gift from Ruth Ramos. Located off Route

28A, this environmentally significant wetland is home to a wide variety of birds and other wildlife.


Throughout the **summer and fall**, BCT volunteers and our trail engineers, Dick Boyden and Don Mears, worked to maintain existing trails, to expand scenic vistas and create new paths.

In October, the BCT announced that a generous friend was offering to match donations up to \$100,000 for the purchase of the George S. Read

Woodland. The response was "right on the money." Donations from regular donors, new donors, and long lost donors poured in—578 of them. Ranging in size from \$5 to \$10,000

for a grand total of \$121,174.00. This enabled the BCT to pay off the mortgage and cover the expenses re-lating to the purchase. Thank you everyone!

Using the new GPS trail guide, BCT trail volunteers crafted these great "You are here" signs, located at many of the trail heads.

**A look ahead:** While the BCT is not currently purchasing any

property there are several pieces that are being considered and it is important to have funds available for deposits on these parcels as they become available. The BCT is an organization managed by volunteers. Much of the land and trail


maintenance is also accomplished by volunteers. However, there is substantial maintenance that requires heavy or special equipment and this work is contracted out. Trail guides,

printing, signs, legal and

accounting services, and other normal operating expenses all add to the organization's financial needs. And so, the BCT continues to ask for your regular and generous support.



### **NEWS & NOTES**



#### Winter Fun Run

On January 7, 2007, the Cape Cod Road Runners hosted the 27th Winter Fun Run. This well-oiled event started and ended at the Weary Travelers Club in Monument Beach with 5 miles of road in between. It was a sunny day in the mid 30s with not much wind, almost perfect conditions for the 205 fun-runners (a record number). The overall winners were Erin Wyner for the ladies with a time of 32:19 and Joe Navas for the gentlemen with a time of 25:35. These times were good, but the course records still stand at: 26:47 women, 24:37 men. After the race, runners were able to refuel with the traditional chowder, corn fritters and camaraderie.

The BCT would like to thank the race organizers and the runners for their efforts and for donating the race proceeds (\$1612.00) to the BCT general fund.

#### **Nature Calls**

As spring approaches, as the ground thaws, and as the flowers burst forth, we will all find ourselves outdoors, walking our old familiar trails and seeking new areas to explore (trail

guide in hand). BCT trails are sometimes very close to private property lines and occasionally cross

those lines, so we would like to remind everyone to respect the rights and privacy of adjacent homeowners.

Many of our properties are enhanced by abutting cranberry bogs-those wonderful red "fields" that are so much a part of the heritage of Cape Cod. Many of us enjoy their beauty and tranquility, however, the bogs and the roads around them are all privately owned and actively farmed. Please be respectful of these beautiful but fragile areas, never walk or allow your dogs to walk on the bogs, and be considerate of farm workers. It is little to ask in return for the enjoyment we all get from the bogs.

And finally, there is pooch patrol. Carry a plastic bag to scoop the poop from the walking trails and the shore areas. Have "Rover" respect other hikers and the property lines of adjacent homeowners. It is

simple, it is courteous, and it is environmentally sound. (Fun Fact: Dog poop takes over a year to decompose in this environment.)

We don't need "good fences" to be "good neighbors," just common courtesy.

If you have ever considered preserving some of your land, now is the time to do it. Federal tax law changes have made 2006 and 2007 the best years ever to donate a conservation restriction and reap the benefit of considerable charitable deductions. 










#### WAYS OF GIVING

**SECURITIES** Gifts of appreciated securities may save on capital gains taxes.

**LIFE INCOME GIFTS** The transfer of cash, securities, or other property to a charitable trust will provide a life income to the donor, donor's spouse, or other beneficiaries. After the death of the last named benficiary, the principal becomes available for use by the BCT. Current tax deductions and eventual estate tax deductions provide a double benefit.

**LIFE INSURANCE** The Bourne Conservation Trust can be named as a beneficiary on a life insurance policy.

**CASH** Cash donations provide immediate funds for use by the BCT and can result in tax savings for the donor.

**WILL** Naming the BCT in your will creates a gift and can reduce or eliminate federal estate taxes.


**BARGAIN SALE** By special arrangement, you may sell your property to the BCT for less than its fair market value (a bargain sale) and the difference is considered a charitable gift.

**CHARITABLE LEAD TRUST** Cash or securities can be placed in a charitable trust for a specified period of time, with income directed to the BCT. At the end of the trust period, the principal reverts to the donor or some other beneficiary.

**REAL ESTATE** Real estate can be given as an outright gift. Such donations have both real estate and income tax benefits.

It's rather ironic because my father was the least likely to ever step into the limelight on his own. He established his self worth by what he could give not receive.

He always put others first and himself last. It made it difficult for my brother and me to give him presents once we reached adulthood because at his birthday or Christmas he would always be on the go, seeing to everybody else's comfort, or putting more logs on the fire, or a thousand other things to do rather than sitting down and being the center of attention and opening his gifts.

I remember my father as always doing—quietly but steadily—in the background—shyly but with pride for us, rarely for his own accomplishments.

In his eyes he valued what he gave. I hope that somehow he can now see that he did matter to others, that the wheel that doesn't squeak gets "oiled" too—that the life he lived and the gift of just being himself was enough—as it was enough just to be able to call him Dad.
